and space. (Refrain)

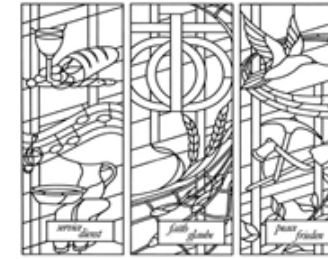
5. Draw together at one table all the human family;
