- **COVID complicates ministry in Thailand** COVID-19 restrictions on travel in Thailand are keeping infection rates down but also making ministry



The visuals for the next months are quilts made by Lori Kliewer Hiebert. The worship committee, upon seeing them, thought they would match the summer theme of Joy!

There are two on display now. "Butterflies for Elsie". Elsie Fast Kliewer was Lori's mom. The quilt was made using Elsie's handkerchiefs, some from as early as 1933 and one from a sewing project learning about blind hemming, circa 1937.

The other is "2020 @ 12:30 pm". Lori recorded the 12:30 pm Altona temperature every day in 2020, assigned colours for ranges of temperatures. The year starts second star from the left and goes down, then left to right. There is a legend explaining the temperatures in the quilt.
