
- De Jongs prepare for service in Ethiopia

- **From the treasurer:** Thank you to all who have continued to give generously to the ongoing work of the church through AMC. As a member congregation of Mennonite Church Canada we are partners with the Colombia Mennonite Church. They are 20 Mennonite Churches in Colombia that share a common vision for Anabaptist witnesses of justice, peace, love and nonviolence. Part of our Sunday donations are passed on to MC Can. where they support the Colombian Mennonite Church through grants for ministries, especially in the areas of leadership development, church planting and missions.

Of course, we also have AMC bills to pay and salaries to honour, even while we have been apart. Fortunately, AMC has received generous Bridge grants, totalling \$20,000. To put this into perspective, our other Revenues are lower than usual, and even in normal times we are often up to, or exceeding our maximum line of credit by this time of the year. This year we are just nearing our line of credit for the first time. Now our steps and ramp project is nearing completion.
