- Turmoil and rising cases in Bethlehem affect Bible college - Bethlehem Bible College asks us to pray for their new academic year as they prepare for classes and enroll students this summer. Located near the checkpoint and two refugee camps, they are often subjected to tear gas, shootings and turmoil in the street. They are also dealing with rising COVID-19 cases, a slow vaccine roll out and less than 15 per cent of the population vaccinated.
- Progress made in Siamou translation Africa Inter-Mennonite Mission asks us to join them in praising God for progress made by the Siamou Bible translation team. Despite several months lost to public health restrictions, work resumed on the books of Mark, Acts, Galatians, 2 Corinthians and Colossians. Pray that progress will be steady so that the Siamou people will soon have the Bible in their own language.

- Bylers to lead EMU program in Thailand this fall

Pray for Myrrl and Ruthie Byler, jointly appointed by Mennonite Church Canada Witness and Mennonite Mission Network to relate to ministry partners in Southeast and Northeast Asia. Although experiencing travel restrictions in Thailand, they are connecting with various partners. Pray for the cross-cultural program they will lead through Eastern Mennonite University in Thailand this fall.
