- MKC postpones assembly due to security reasons

Meserete Kristos Church president Desalegn Abebe asks for prayer for peace in Ethiopia. Due to security problems in the northern and western parts of the country, the MKC General Assembly planned for late August is now postponed. Pray for church leaders that continue to visit and encourage the church in various regions of the country.

- Annual AIMM meetings planned for October

Please pray for the annual meetings of Africa Inter-Mennonite Mission planned for October in Burkina Faso and Congo. Pray that COVID-19 restrictions and visa requirements will allow leaders to gather, to encourage each other and learn together.

- Ongoing struggle in Minnesota against Canadian pipeline development

- More than 600 people have been arrested or received citations over protests amid growing opposition to the Line 3, a proposed oil sands pipeline expansion by Enbridge to bring Alberta tar sands oil to Wisconsin, through wetlands and the treaty territory of Anishinaabe peoples, through the Mississippi River headwaters to the shore of Lake Superior. Native American tribes and Indigenous-led environmental organizations such as [Honor the Earth](#) are leading opposition efforts in court and on the ground.

Vision



- **Coffee On Sunday morning!** Dave Regehr and Pastor Dan will be leading a discussion/study group before the service. Please consider joining this time of fellowship and discovery.

- After discussion and much prayer, the Formation Committee has decided to postpone Sunday School classes due to current COVID restrictions, uncertainties of COVID this fall, and lack of Sunday School teachers. AMC would potentially have 12 Sunday School students for the 2021-2022 year. The

Formation Committee feels this might be a time for the AMC community to contemplate new ways of moving forward with Christian Education at AMC.

- From the treasurer:

Part of AMC's giving supports Mennonite Church Canada's program Company of 1000. This ministry is administered in consultation with Church Leadership Ministers. Company of 1000 is a Study Reserve Fund that supports the training of pastors for the congregations of Mennonite Church Canada. Money from the fund is used to reduce the personal cost of preparation for ministry and to encourage pastors and pastoral candidates to attend preferred schools through the granting of forgivable loans and tuition grants. Like many pastors in MCM, Pastor Dan applied for and received forgivable loans as he studied at AMBS and CMU in preparation for ministry that were reduced annually based on pastoral employment in an MCM congregation.

Of course, we also have AMC bills to pay and salaries to honour, even while we have been apart. Fortunately, AMC has received generous Bridge grants, totalling \$20,000. To put this into perspective, our other Revenues are lower than usual, and even in normal times we are often up to, or exceeding our maximum line of credit by this time of the year. This year we are just nearing our line of credit for the first time.
