May God prepare our hearts for this purpose-filled work, Marilyn, For the AMC Worship Committee

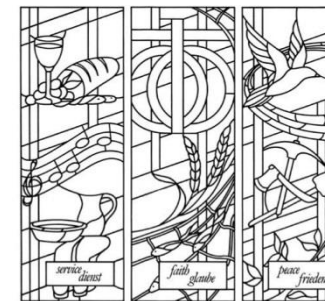
