- We pray for the family care-givers.

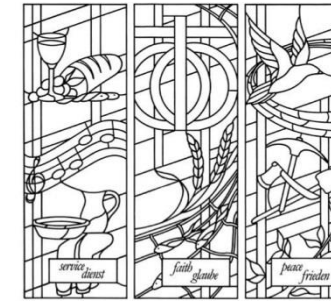
Prayer for Our Community
