- We pray for Anna Penner as she begins her treatment for cancer.

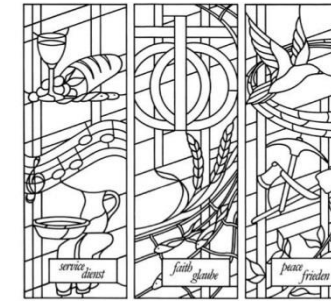
Prayer for Our Community
