- Thai and Lao participants of the Anabaptist Mennonite Biblical Seminary Journey program study online and in small groups for most of the year but will be gathering Feb. 2-5 in Khon Kaen, Thailand to study together with mentors and teachers. Praise God for this opportunity. Pray for Witness workers, Tom and Christine Poovong, as they host this gathering and work with translation in the program.
- Meserete Kristos Church, Ethiopia, asks us to pray for peace and stability in Ethiopia. As many areas of the country become too dangerous for travel, regional church leaders are restricting visits to congregations. On February 9, Mennonites will gather publicly in Ottawa and other centres around the country to sing hymns, pray, deliver petitions, and call on our political leaders to support a path forward based on justice, nonviolence, international law, and compassion.

Isaiah 43:2


When you pass through the waters, I will be with you, and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.
