July 29-Aug 4: In the office

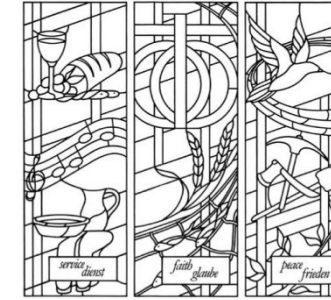
Aug 5-11: At Camp Koinonia (I'll have WiFi)
